

The [Six Army Functional Concepts](#) list Required Capabilities in Appendix B.

1. **Mission Command** emphasizes the need for Army forces to operate across multiple domains and as part of joint, interorganizational, and multinational teams.
2. **Movement and Maneuver** proposes a concept and the required capabilities necessary to provide commanders with multiple options to seize and control terrain, defeat or destroy enemy forces, and protect populations, activities, and infrastructure to achieve military objectives.
3. **Intelligence** identifies the key challenges, solutions, and supporting capabilities required to enable the intelligence warfighting function to support joint combined arms operations across all phases in complex environments against increasingly capable opponents to accomplish campaign objectives and protect U.S. national interests.
4. **Fires** describes how future fires leaders, Soldiers, organizations, and platforms work as part of joint, interorganizational, and multinational efforts, to support joint combined arms operations, national military strategies, and the national interest. 5. **Maneuver Support** describes how maneuver support forces provide reinforcing and complementary capabilities to support the future force.
6. **Sustainment** discusses how sustainment forces will support and enable future multi-domain battle (MDB) and cross-domain maneuver.
