

MAJ Davin E. Bridges, Dr PH was born in Dallas, Texas. He graduated from Northwestern State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemistry in 1997, graduated from McNeese State University with a Master of Science in Chemistry in 2000, and graduated from Capella University with Doctorate of Public Health in 2015.

MAJ Bridges was a direct commission in 2005 as a Medical Service Corps First Lieutenant. He started his career out as a Brigade Environmental/Engineering Officer within the 94th Brigade Support Battalion (BSB), 4th Brigade, 10th Mountain Division (MTNDIV), Fort Polk, La. He was also assigned an additional duty as the Assistant S3, 94th BSB, 4th Brigade, 10th MTNDIV. After deploying with the unit to Afghanistan, he served as the Deployment Environmental Surveillance Program Manager, Public Health Center Region-Europe, Landstuhl, Germany. After spending time in Europe, he commanded the 61st Medical Detachment (Preventive Medicine), 86th Combat Support Hospital; Chief, Fort Campbell, KY. From there, MAJ Bridges served as the Environmental Health Chief at Eisenhower Medical Center, Fort Gordon, GA. After transitioning from spending a year at Fort Leavenworth, KS at Command General and Staff College, he served as the Chief Special Functions Team in the 82nd Civil Affairs Battalion, 85th Civil Affairs Brigade, Fort Stewart, GA. MAJ Bridges is currently the TRADOC Command Surgeon Executive Officer.
